Kitchen - Where Could a Fall Happen?

Hazards: 1-climbing out of the highchair 2- climbing on the chair 3-pulling the tablecloth

Prevention: 1-supervision 2-using the belt while the child is in the highchair 3- removing the tablecloth 4-pushing the chair close to the table so the base is underneath the table

Bathroom - Where Could a Fall Happen?

Hazards: 1-water on the floor 2-slippery bathtub

Prevention: 1-supervision 2-non slip bathtub mat 3-dry up the water on the floor 4-keep door closed when not in the bathroom

Nursery - Where Could a Fall Happen?

Hazards: 1-climbing on the rocking chair 2- rolling off the change table 3-fall out of the crib (drop-side crib) 4- falling from the window

Prevention: 1-supervision 2-hands on the child at all times on the change table 3- window guards/widow closed & locked 4-drop-side cribs prohibited

Living Room - Where Could a Fall Happen?

Hazards: 1-climbing on any furniture (table, chairs, shelves) 2- stairs 3-tripping over toys on the ground 4- tripping on electric cords 5- fall out the window

Prevention: 1-supervision 2-picking up toys when not in use 3-safety gates at the top and bottom of the stairs & removing items from the stairs 4-make sure electric cords are plugged in out of reach 5- Securing tall furniture to the wall 6-closing and locking windows & moving furniture away from the windows
